

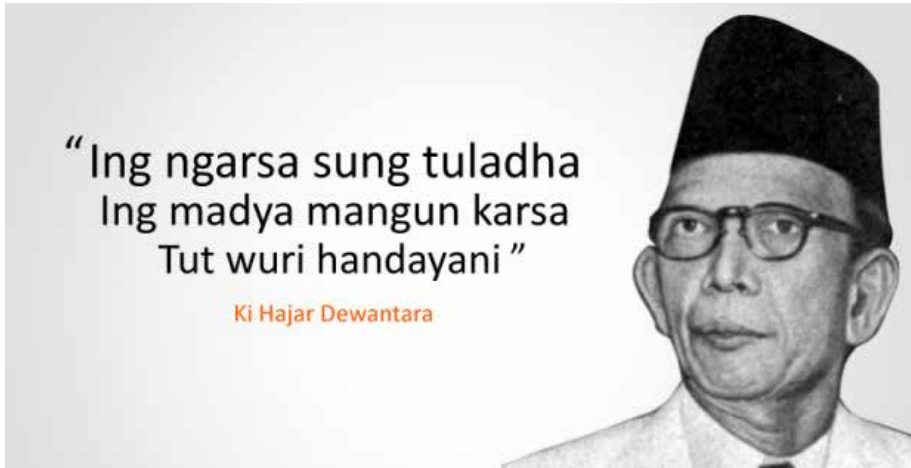

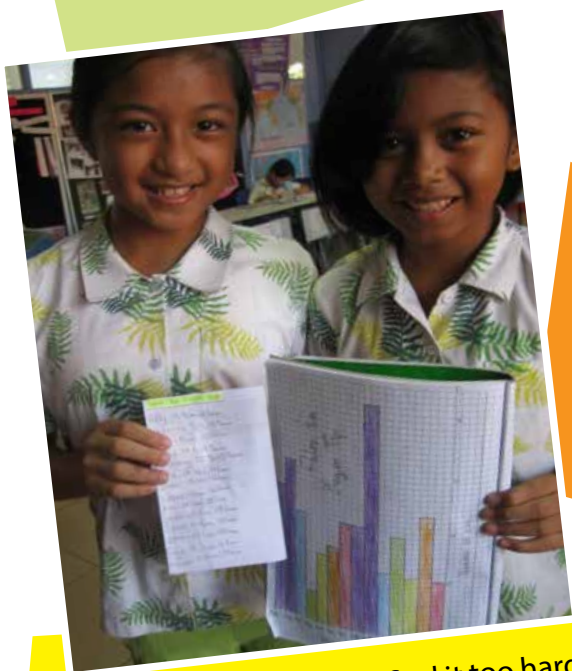
We had everyone assembled ready for the roll call in 2.52 seconds – impressive!



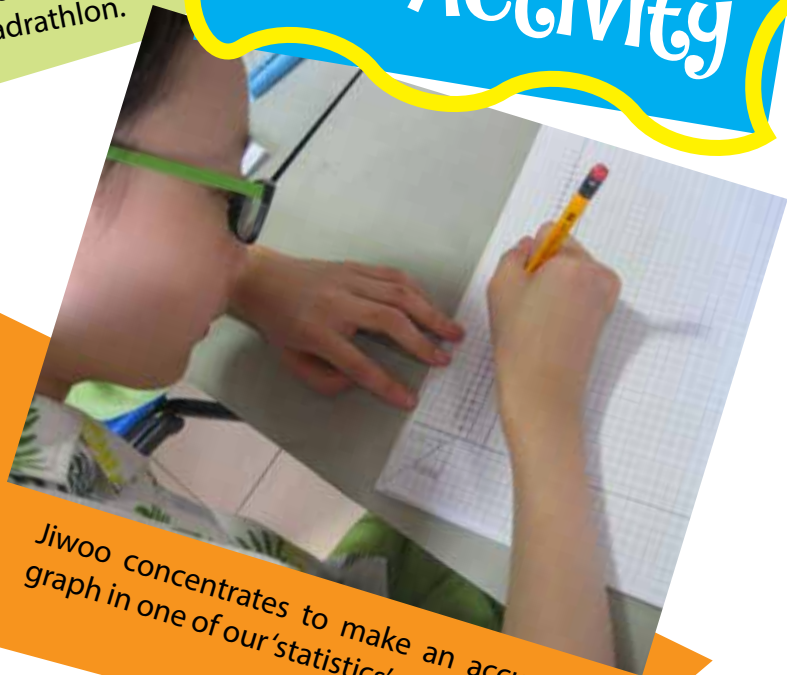


The Tanjung Lesung sailors Zara, Minho and Maisya (in the distance) competing in the quadrathlon.
