Tindra and Chloe are guessing how heavy a container will be when it's filled with sand. Great guessing!

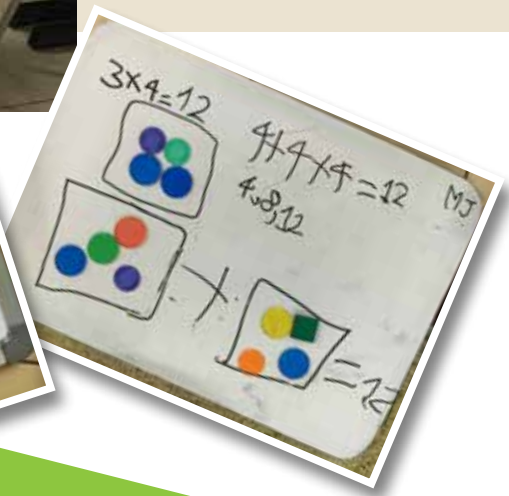
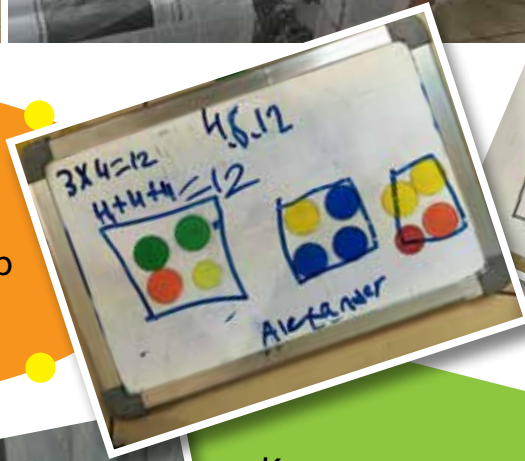
