We began the year with a class treaty where we promised to be respectful and responsible learners; and cooperative games enabled us to learn more about each other and the importance of listening to each other and working together as a team.

As we explored our "Beginnings" theme, we created self portraits of ourselves and mapped out where our families all came from in the world map – we are a diverse group of learners! For math we learned that statistics gave us more information about ourselves and our families. We also explored non-standard units of measurement as well as the basic facts and strategies for solving problems.

In literacy, we explored both fiction and non-fiction texts and created acrostic poems and creative poems about who we are. To research our ideal class pet, we used both library and ICT resources to learn more about their habitat, food and needs, then created our posters. This ties in well with our science studies where we will also explore reactions, the three states of matter and the water cycle.

To celebrate the Treaty of Waitangi, we explored the history of the treaty and created koru and kiwi bird art using pastels and dye.
