NZIS Secondary Academic year 2018 offers the following academic levels of learning for the academic year 2018.

- Students will complete Secondary School Education in 6 years of time, which are named below with the expected levels of achievement throughout academic year 2018.
- ❖ Secondary 1 – End of Year NZIS Assessments (November 2018). (If needed, Primary checkpoint examinations given in June '18)
- ❖ Secondary 2 – **Secondary Checkpoint Examination – June 2018** & End of Year NZIS Assessments – November 2018
- ❖ Secondary 3 – End of Year NZIS Assessments (November 2018) – IGCSE first year of Preparation
- ❖ Secondary 4 – **Cambridge IGCSE summer examinations – June 2018**, Prepare for ASL taken June 2019.
- ❖ Junior College 1 – **Cambridge Advanced Subsidiary Level Examinations – November 2018** – 1 year of complete study
- ❖ Junior College 2 – **Cambridge Advanced Level Examinations – June 2018** – A semester with selective subjects only

The four stages lead seamlessly from Primary to Secondary and Pre-University years. Each stage – Cambridge Primary, Cambridge Lower Secondary, Cambridge Upper secondary and Cambridge Advanced – builds on the learners' development from the previous one, but can also be offered separately.

Five elements lie at the heart of Cambridge Education: International curriculum, teaching and learning, assessment, International recognition and global community.

❖ Primary Checkpoint Examinations

Cambridge Primary, typically for learners **aged 5 to 11 years**, gives schools a world-class curriculum to develop learner skills and understanding in English, mathematics and science. It enables teachers to assess children's learning as they progress with two optional assessments: Cambridge Primary Progression Tests and Cambridge Primary Checkpoint. Its curriculum frameworks for English also include an 'English as a second language' option.

Cambridge Lower Secondary is typically for learners **aged 11 to 14 years**.

Cambridge Lower Secondary Checkpoint tests have been designed to assess learners at the end of Cambridge Lower Secondary. They are available in English, English as a second language, mathematics and science, and give valuable feedback on learners' strengths and weaknesses before they progress to the next stage of education.

The tests are marked in Cambridge and provide schools with an external international benchmark for learner performance. Each learner receives a statement of achievement and a diagnostic feedback report, giving schools detailed information and parents extra trust in the feedback they receive.
